Dear New Jersey Black Sea Bass Permit Holder:
New Jersey Black Sea Bass Dealer:

As of July 1, 2009 the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife has determined that approximately 7,950 pounds of black sea bass will have been landed since the July 1 - September 30 directed season opened on July 1, 2009. Based upon this information and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-18.12(h), the New Jersey directed black sea bass fishery will be closed as of 8:00 PM, July 5, 2009.

Effective 8:01 PM, July 5, 2009 no vessel shall land or possess and no dealer shall accept any black sea bass in excess of the by-catch trip limit of 50 pounds through September 30, 2009 or until such time as the seasonal by-catch is projected to be taken. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold.

The directed black sea bass fishery will re-open on October 1, 2009 with a 500 pound trip limit with a maximum of two landings per week **OR** 1,000 pound trip limit with a maximum of one landing per week. If you have any questions, please contact the Bureau of Marine Fisheries at 609-748-2020.
